Glamour Photography  
Sunday, July 16

Nationally recognized photographers, coordinated by Larry Ferguson, will conduct workshops on glamour 3D photography. Each panel member will come prepared with about 10-15 minutes of material on how he/she shoots models. The rest of the time will be an audience question and answer period.

On Sunday afternoon, from 3:15 - 6PM, there will be a glamour photography session with professional models and studio lighting. Full Registration and a fee are required and spaces are limited. The first hour will be used to show how to set up lighting, backgrounds, cameras, etc. using the real equipment. The second and third hour will be with the models. In small groups, the participants will rotate to each site with a different model with the panel members providing helpful advice.
